## 『RI会長からのメッセージ』

## 2016年6月



英国の作家で空軍飛行士でもあったロアルド・ダールは、熱烈な写真撮影家としても知られ、多くの旅に愛用のツァイス製カメラを持参していました。フィルムやガラス製ネガを用いて一枚ずつ手間をかけて現像を行っていた時代に、何百枚もの写真コレクションがありました。後年、これらの写真は旅行のビジュアル資料となり、体験記を綴ったり、人に紹介したりするときの手助けとなりました。しかし、彼が記憶を頼りに語るときは常に、写真よりも鮮明な描写が生まれました。物事や経験の多くは形に残すことが単純に不可能であり、画像や文字では正確に伝えられないとダールは話しています。

言葉では言い尽くせず、写真は色あせ、記憶も当てにならず、そして細部が失われていきます。 しかしダールが言うように、決して色あせず、何十年経っても記憶の中心で火柱のように輝き 続ける経験もあります。その火柱は記憶の大海原に高々と立ち、その前後の人生を決定的に 分ける境界線となります。

この喩えは、過去1年間、ロータリーを通じて世界中を巡った私の経験にも当てはまります。この1年間は、私の記憶の中で高く燃え上がる火柱となり、運命の分岐点となりました。

この12カ月間を振り返ると、日々の一つひとつの情景が、万華鏡のように代わる代わる思い返されます。命をつなぐ心臓手術を受け、快方に向かう子どものそばで心配そうに見守るチャンディーガル(インド)の親。破壊的な震災からの復旧を果たした村のあちこちで、生き生きとはためいていたネパールの国旗。サンピエトロ広場で行われたロータリアンの祝典で、ローマ教皇から祝福を受けたときの畏敬の念。そして、世界中の多くの国で、さまざまな言語と接しつつ、初めてお会いしたロータリーの方々との楽しいひと時。

国際ロータリー会長としての経験は、写真や言葉では真に語りつくせない壮大な任務で、光輝燦然たる火柱となって私の記憶に留まっています。幾千の場面がその記憶や感情とともに頭の中をめぐり、一つの大きなモザイク画となります。そのモザイク画の一片一片は、皆さんによって実現された素晴らしい活動の数々です。

本年度も終わりに近づき、この素晴らしい団体の一員としてさらに大きな誇りを感じています。 ロータリーは、世界をより豊かにし、絶望を希望に変え、不運の人びとに上昇への道を示す、 多くの人への贈りもの。そして私たちは、ロータリーを通じて、「世界へのプレゼント」になるので す。

## 『2026年国際大会情報』

### 国連事務総長 潘基文氏

5月29日、韓国で開催中のロータリー国際大会開会式で、ポリオ撲滅は「あと少し」と述べる国連事務総長潘基文氏。

韓国で開催中の第107回ロータリー国際大会。これまでで最も多くのロータリアンが出席し、多文化の非営利団体リーダーの集まりとしては韓国最大級のものとなった今大会では、国連の潘基文事務総長が開会式に出席し、会場となったKINTEX会議場(高陽市)に集まった何千人という出席者に語りかけました。「ロータリアンは素晴らしい活動を世界中で行っています。……皆さんの活動は、国連が目標を達成し、世界からの理解を得る上で大きな力となっています」

70年前の5月に国連創設のための話し合いに参加したアラン・アルバート元ロータリー会長について触れた潘氏は、次のように言いました。「人知の擁護者であるアルバート元会長は、一人ひとりが平和の推進力となるよう人びとに呼びかけました。このビジョンを実現させるために、私たちは協力して活動しています」

2007年以来、国連のトップとしてその野心的な開発アジェンダの指揮にあたってきた韓国出身の潘事務総長は、ロータリーのリーダーシップと、人道的活動への懸命な取り組みに感謝を述べました。特に、ポリオ撲滅のための資金調達とアドボカシー活動におけるロータリーの貢献を強調しました。世界ポリオ撲滅推進活動(GPEI)におけるユニセフの役割に言及した事務総長は、「身体を麻痺させるこの病気を撲滅するために力になれることを、国連は誇りとしている」と述べました。「今後も闘いを続けなければなりません。引き続き声を大きくして、各国政府からの支援が必要であることを訴え、撲滅キャンペーンへの認識向上をご支援ください」

地元韓国の文化にあふれた開会式では、正式な講演の前に、伝統的な太鼓と舞踊、武道、K-popといったパフォーマンスが披露され、聴衆の気分を高揚しました。

この度、第 2640 地区が 2015-16 年度ガバナーを選出する 2 度目の手続きを完了したと伺いました。直前ガバナーの北中登一 氏が実施した1度目の選出手続きでは、2012 年 9 月に豊澤洋太朗 氏を選出し、同年10月にRIへ必要書類を提出しています。これに対して当時、異議や選挙手続きに関する申し立ては RI に一切提出されませんでした。

ところが、久保様がガバナーに就任後、豊澤ガバナーノミニーは失職したとの通知を発行の上、2 度目の選出手続きが実施されました。2014 年3 月に完了したこの 2 度目の選出手続きでは、2015-16 年度ガバナーとして新たに岡本浩氏を選出するとの通知が地区内クラブに送られました。

ここでご留意いただきたい点は、1度目のガバナー選出手続きは正規に実施されたものであり、豊澤ガバナーノミニーを失格とする根拠がないことです。さらに、地区ガバナーには、既に完了したガバナー選出手続きを無効としたり、選出済みのガバナーノミニーを失格とする権限はありません。

従って、豊澤洋太朗氏が第 2640 地区 2015-16 年度地区ガバナーであることをここに確認し、ロータリーの「超我の奉仕」の精神の下、久保様をはじめ地区内すべてのロータリアンが豊澤氏をサポートするようお願いいたします。またこの点について、至急、地区内クラブへ通知を行ってください。岡本浩氏については、将来の地区ガバナー候補としてご検討いただくことを奨励いたします。

第 2640 地区における論争は未だ解決に至っていないことから、小沢一彦管理委員に引き続き、私の特別代表となっていただくことを依頼し、恒久的な解決に向けた調整をお願いしました。ゲイリー・ホァンRI 会長エレクトも、2014-15 年度に小沢管理委員が続けて調整役を務めることに同意しています。

第 2640 地区が相違を乗り越えて前向きな解決策を見出せるよう、地区リーダーと地区内ロータリアンが協力することを改めてお願いいたします。まずはこれまでの紛糾を過去のものと考えてはじめて、地区を健全な状態に戻し、ロータリーを実践しみんなに豊かな人生を実現するための真の奉仕に取り組むことができるはずです。

### ロータリー親睦活動月間

- 6月はロータリー親睦活動月間です。日本のロータリアンは、これ をクラブにおける親睦活動と誤解して、本来の意味を理解していな い方が大多数のように思います。
- ・ ロータリー親睦活動はRIの国際奉仕部門における常設プログラムです。国際奉仕というと、ともすれば従来の世界社会奉仕(WCS)に代表される人道的ボランティア活動であるかのように思われる傾向があります。しかしながら、国際奉仕はロータリーの目的第4項の表現を借りれば、「奉仕の理念で結ばれた職業人が、世界的ネットワークを通じて、国際理解、親善、平和を推進すること」とあるように、ロータリー親睦活動はその一環であります。
- 1928年に結成されたエスペラント語親睦グループをはじめ多くのグループが世界親睦活動(World Fellowships Activities = WFA)という名で活動しており、1970年にはRIの構成プログラムとなりました。1989年には共通の職業を持つ「国際職業連絡グループ (International Vocational Contact Group = IVCG)」が試験的プログラムとして発足し、1993年には先の親睦活動グループと統合され、「ロータリー趣味・職業別親睦活動(Rotary Recreational and Vocational Fellowship = RRVF)」となりました。2000年10月、RI理事会は6月を「ロータリー趣味・職業別親睦活動月間」として特別月間と位置づけました。

同じ興味や情熱をもつ世界中の仲間たちと交流できる方法、それが「ロータリー親睦活動グループ」です。ロータリアン、ロータリアンの家族、ロータリープログラムの参加者や学友ならどなたでも参加できるこのグループは、世界中に会員がいるロータリーならではの国際交流の機会です。次ページでロータリー親睦活動一覧を表示します。関心のあるグループを見つけたら、ロータリー親睦活動グループ名簿を参考に、グループに直接連絡を取ってみましょう。またフォーラムで、同じ関心を持つロータリアンやローターアクターのグループを探し、交流を深めることもできます。
